Travel grants for early career scientists to promote scientific exchange 2022

The travel funds offered by MeteoXchange (www.meteoxchange.de) are intended for the exchange of two or more early career scientists in the field of atmospheric sciences. While digital tools have been able to offset the decrease in traditional networking opportunities in the past months, we want to encourage in-person networking and will select three teams to provide with travel funds. The exchange should focus on the scientific aspects of each of the team members' work and enable future collaborations. The team can decide how the travel funds will be distributed, e.g. for a single visit to one of the research institutes for a short-term stay, or collective travel to a conference (e.g. EGU). Travel has to occur until April 2022.

PURPOSE

- Scientific exchange of two or more early career atmospheric scientists working in the same field in the period from the beginning of January to the end of April 2022
- Presentation of current research with discussion of future collaborations
- Encourage international exchange and networking

ELIGIBILITY

- A team consists of a minimum of two people from two different institutes (international collaboration is strongly encouraged).
- All team members must be early career scientists, which we define as having received their highest degree (BSc, MSc or PhD) within the past five years (excluding time spent on parental leave)

AMOUNT OF FUNDING

Each recipient team will have access to a total of **2,500 €** to be used for travel funds.

HOW TO APPLY

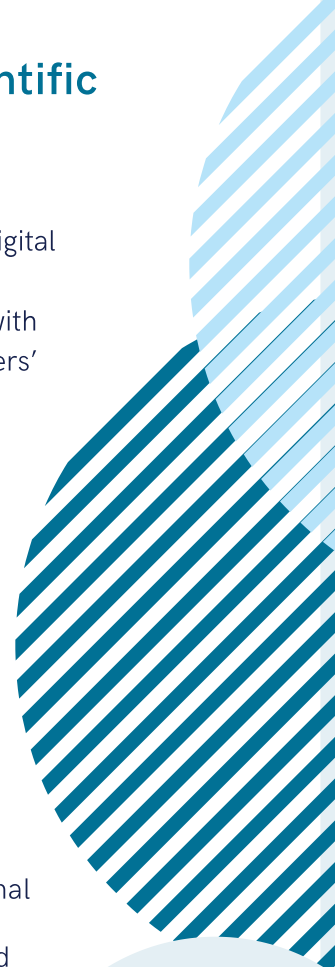
Please send the following documents to info@meteoxchange.de as one PDF document:

- CV for each team member limited to professional information (max. two pages)
- Summary of current research (ca. 0.5 pages per team member)
- A joint letter on the implementation of the planned exchange and the associated scientific objectives including possible future collaborations, as well as an estimate of the expected costs (max. two pages)
- Each of the applicants must submit a brief letter of support from a senior scientist at their respective institute who supports the exchange (max. one page)

DEADLINE

The application documents must be submitted by **30 November 2021**. Successful teams will be notified by **17 December 2021**.
